



LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

LISTENING

- L1 Shows interest in listening to sounds
- L2 Listens with interest to language of others
- L3 Responds to verbal communication of others
- L4 Responds to nonverbal communication of others
- L5 Begins to understand gestures, words, questions or routines

COMMUNICATING

- L6 Uses sounds, gestures, or actions to express needs and wants
- L7 Uses consistent sounds, gestures or words to communicate
- L8 Imitates sounds, gestures or words
- L9 Uses sounds, signs or words for a variety of purposes
- L10 Shows reciprocity in using language in simple conversations

EMERGENT LITERACY

- L11 Shows interest in songs, rhymes, and stories
- L12 Shows interest in photos, pictures, and drawings
- L13 Demonstrates interest and involvement with books and other print materials
- L14 Begins to recognize and understand symbols

SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

TRUST

- SE1 Engages in behaviors that build relationships with familiar adults
- SE2 Shows preference for familiar adults
- SE3 Responds to unfamiliar adults cautiously
- SE4 Seeks ways to find comfort in new situations
- SE5 Shows emotional connection and attachment to others

RELATIONSHIPS

- SE6 Shows interest in and awareness of other children
- SE7 Responds to and interacts with other children
- SE8 Begins to recognize and respond to other children's feelings and emotions
- SE9 Begins to show concern for others
- SE10 Learns social skills, and eventually words, for expressing feelings, needs and wants
- SE11 Uses imitation or pretend play to learn new roles and relationships

SELF AWARENESS

- SE12 Expresses feelings and emotions through facial expressions, sounds or gestures
- SE13 Develops awareness of self as separate from others
- SE14 Shows confidence in increasing abilities

SELF REGULATION

- SE15 Begins to manage own behavior and show self-regulation
- SE16 Shows ability to cope with stress
- SE17 Shows increasing independence
- SE18 Understands simple routines, rules or limitations

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

GROSS MOTOR

- PH 1 Moves body, arms and legs with coordination
- PH 2 Demonstrates large muscle balance, stability, control and coordination
- PH 3 Develops increasing ability to change positions and move body from place to place
- PH 4 Moves body with purpose to achieve a goal

FINE MOTOR

- PH 5 Uses hands or feet to make contact with objects or people
- PH 6 Develops small muscle control and coordination
- PH 7 Coordinates eye and hand movements
- PH 8 Uses different actions on objects (kicks, shakes, pats, swipes)
- PH 9 Controls small muscles in hands when doing simple tasks

WELLNESS

- PH 10 Shows characteristics of healthy development
- PH 11 Responds when physical needs are met
- PH 12 Expresses physical needs nonverbally or verbally
- PH 13 Participates in physical care routines
- PH 14 Begins to develop self-help skills
- PH 15 Begins to understand safe and unsafe behaviors

COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT

EXPLORATION

- C1 Pays attention to people and objects
- C2 Uses senses to explore people, objects, and the environment
- C3 Attends to colors, shapes, patterns or pictures
- C4 Shows interest and curiosity in new people and objects
- C5 Makes things happen and watches for results or repeats actions

MEMORY

- C6 Shows ability to acquire and process new information
- C7 Recognizes familiar people, places, and things
- C8 Recalls and uses information in new situations
- C9 Searches for missing or hidden objects

PROBLEM SOLVING

- C10 Experiments with different uses for objects
- C11 Shows imagination and creativity in solving problems
- C12 Uses a variety of strategies to solve problems
- C13 Applies knowledge to new situations

DRAMATIC PLAY

- C14 Observes and imitates sounds, gestures or behavior
- C15 Uses objects in new ways or in pretend play
- C16 Uses imitation or pretend play to express creativity and imagination
